On 4/19/95, SA's Francis J. Pellegrino, FBI, NYC, and Brian G. Parr, conducted an interview of Lieutenant Philip Rojas, Bureau of Prisons, Metropolitan Correctional Center, with regard to a verbal, as well as written statement by ABDUL HAKIM MURAD claiming that he was responsible, as a member of the Liberation Army, for the bombing of the Federal Building in Oklahoma City. MURAD is currently incarcerated for his involvement in the conspiracy to bomb United States airlines in Manila.

Rojas advised that the prison guard responsible for Murad on the morning of April 19 was listening to the radio when a news report came over the air describing the bombing of the Federal Building in Oklahoma City. When the news report concluded, the guard asked MURAD what he thought of the bombing. Murad responded to the guard's question by stating that the Liberation Army was responsible for the bombing. MURAD made no other verbal statements.

A short time later, MURAD passed a note to the guard, again claiming that the Liberation Army was responsible for the bombing in Oklahoma City.
